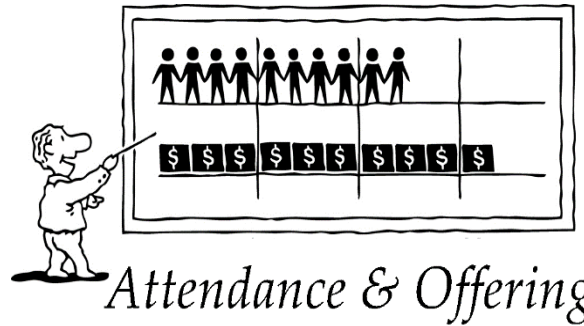

EGGS SWISS by Sharon Schaefer.

12 slices bread, decrusted and cubed. ½#

Swiss cheese grated or other cheese.

Sprinkle bread into 9 x 13 pan, sprinkle cheese over bread. Beat 4 eggs & 2 ½ cups of milk, salt and pepper to taste. Pour over bread. Make a topping of sausage, ham, bacon (already fried). Bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes. Cool 20 minutes before cutting. Serves 9.
