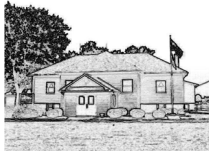

Following the completion of our books, we will work on multiplication tables and review important concepts with games and fun challenges.

Students will work on writing 5 paragraph essays this week for language arts. We will also review our parts of speech, noun jobs, and types of verbs. In science, students will prepare presentations on their assigned planet to present to the class. In social studies, we journey to our last region of the United States, the West. Each student will also prepare a travel brochure to the state of his or her choice, highlighting interesting facts, geography features, the state flag and bird, along with the history of their state. They will present their state to the class as well.

In spelling, we complete Lesson 23 with our test on Friday. You will find their memory written in their

planners on Monday. It's going to be another great week.
